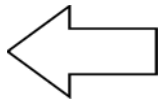
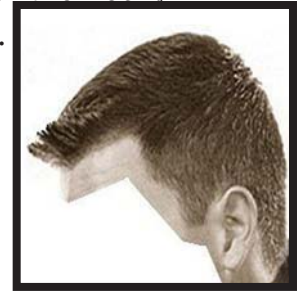


Acceptable for Boys

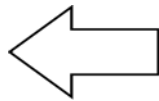
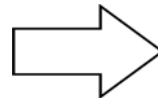


← This is the proper taper on the nape of the neck, side of the head, and around the ears.

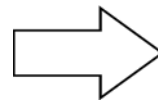
This is a proper tapered cut with proper sideburns that do not pass the middle of the ear, and with an acceptable "spike" in front.



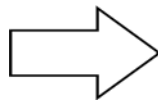
These are examples of ironed, and collared shirts; ironed and creased pants; belts; and acceptable casual or dress shoes.



These pants have proper creases.



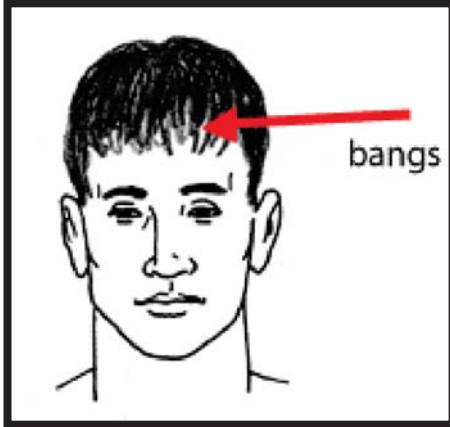
These shoes are acceptable for school *any* day, including Wednesdays and other dress-up days.



Casual shoes are appropriate for any day except Wednesdays and other dress-up days.

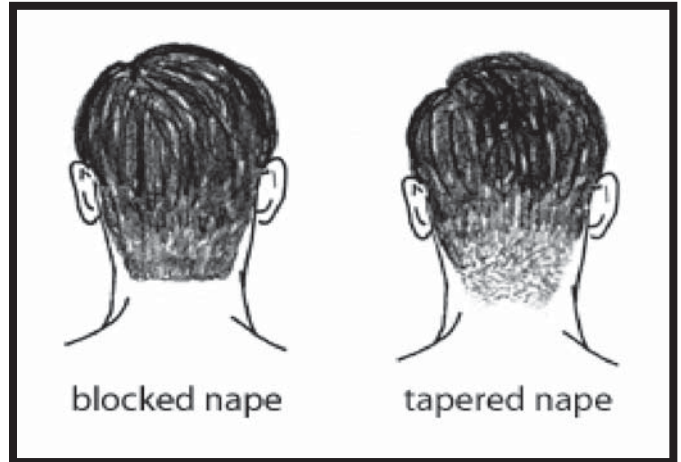


Unacceptable for Boys



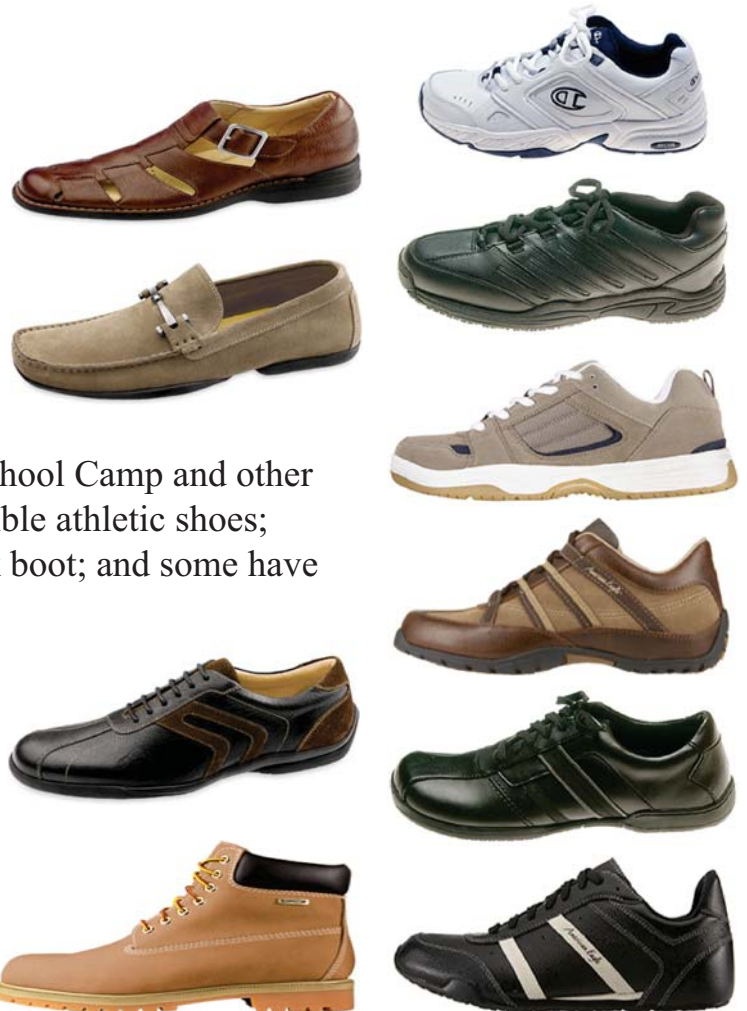
Although bangs are allowed to hang down the forehead no lower than one finger-width above the eyebrows, this or any other un-combed or spiked style is not allowed.

The hair on the nape of the neck is to be tapered, NOT blocked.



These pants do not have a proper crease.

These shoes are acceptable ONLY for School Camp and other announced activities. Some are or resemble athletic shoes; some will not hold a shine; one is a work boot; and some have cut-outs or open shoes.



Construction boots of any kind are unacceptable. However, this shoe in a darker color that holds a shine and is cut below the ankle is acceptable.
