

**Hammond Baptist Junior High School**  
**Math Policies**  
**2008-2009**

1. A student's math grade is simply an average of the tests from that six-weeks' grading period.
2. A student may retake each test one time.
3. Before retaking a test, a student must correct all incorrect answers on the previous test.
4. The test must be retaken within one week of the original test.
5. One math lesson is taught each day (except for Wednesday in Algebra  $\frac{1}{2}$  and Algebra 1) and is due the following day.
6. An incomplete math lesson results in one point being taken off the student's final grade and a trip to the office.
7. All work for the lessons must be shown in the student's math workbook in order for the lesson to be considered complete.
8. Each student is responsible for grading his/her lesson. It is then checked by the teacher.
9. Each student will receive one "alibi" per six weeks. An "alibi" is an incomplete lesson. The lesson must be finished by the next class period; however, the student will not be sent to the office.
10. Any student who does not use his "alibi" during a six-weeks' grading period will be awarded four points on his final grade.
11. Wednesday is test day.
